

## Call for small project grants



### Supporting capacity building of health care workforce in LMICs

**Global Doctors** (Globale Læger) is a Danish NGO that was established in 2008 with the mission to improve global health by supporting healthcare workers and healthcare systems capacity building around the world. We are passionate about improving the conditions and capacities of healthcare workers who live and work in areas with vulnerable populations by strengthening their knowledge and skills, helping to improve infrastructure, and improving access to healthcare. For this reason, we are launching this call to support small activities that **aim to increase the knowledge and skills of healthcare workers and build capacity for healthcare systems in low- and middle-income countries (LMICs).**

#### What will we support?

We will support **concrete activities with clear short-term outcomes.**

Some potential examples (**this is not an exhaustive list**): postgraduate continuing education, symposiums, workshops, creation of partnerships and support of knowledge exchange (e.g. meetings, workshops and knowledge exchange between organisations that aim to strengthen the capacity of the healthcare workforce), training of community health workers, field visits with the aim to promote knowledge exchange and capacity building of the local healthcare workforce, access to resources that will be used to strengthen capacity of the local healthcare workforce, transportation of a keynote speaker/educator, etc.

#### Our Budget

2500 USD divided into 2-3 projects.

#### Who can apply?

Non-for-profit civil society organizations working with all types of healthcare workers in countries listed in the last version of the DAC list ([see list](#)). The organizations do not

necessarily need to be based in the listed countries, but the activity **must be implemented** in a country that belongs to the DAC list.

Examples of civil society organizations:

- Nongovernmental organizations (NGOs)
- Professional associations and medical societies
- Churches and other faith-based organizations
- Unions
- Cooperatives

### **Key dates**

- **Opening of the call:** 15th July, 2021
- **Grant Application due date:** 30th September, 2021 -23:59 CEST
- **Review of applications by GD board:** October, 2021
- **Notification of results:** 31st October, 2021
- The activity must be implemented **between December 2021 and March 2022.**

### **Good to know before applying**

- The agreement is signed between organization. Thus, you must have legal authority to sign on behalf of your organization.
- The person signing the agreement is responsible for the design, implementation, and timely reporting of the activity. Global Doctors must not be involved in any aspect of project development, nor the implementation of the activity.
- The grant is given in two instalments.
  - The first 50% after approval of the proposal.
  - The second 50% after receiving a brief report of the activity including pictures and all invoices of the expenses.
